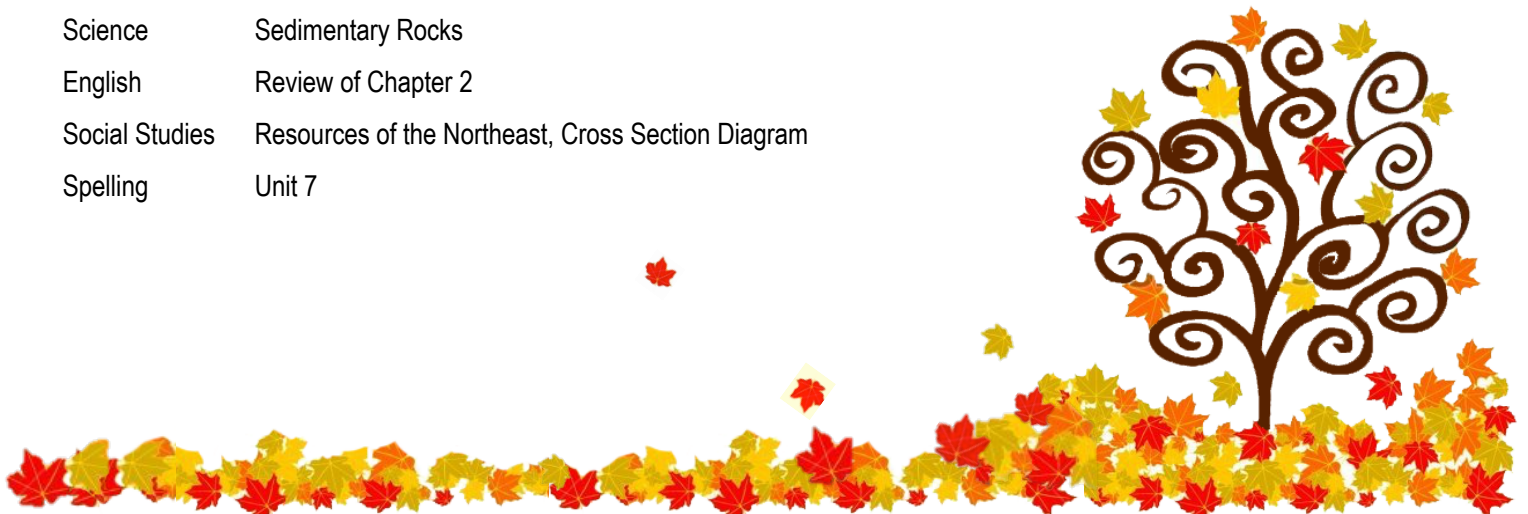

REMINDERS AND INFORMATION

GYM SHOES – Students need to have gym shoes (rubber, non-marking sole) for gym days. Our gym days are **MONDAY AND WEDNESDAY**. If they don't have gym shoes, they won't be able to participate in gym class.

UNIFORM DRESS CODE

SHOES – Students may only wear gym shoes or dress shoes.
